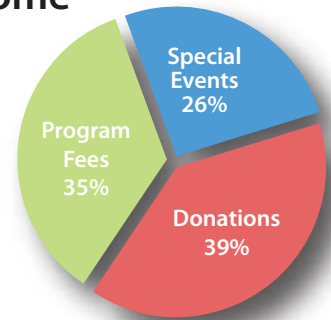
In 2012, the cost to operate the facility for 1 day = \$664

80 cents of every dollar was spent on therapeutic riding programs

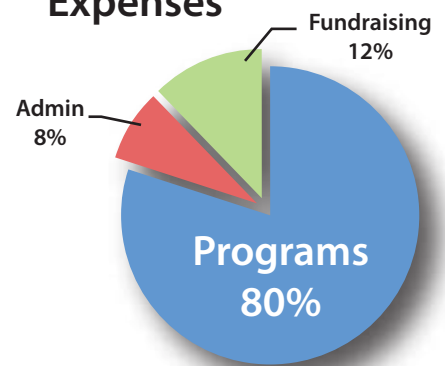
Riverwood served an average of 92 students per week. Riverwood subsidizes approximately 65% of the cost of riding lessons for all participants; beyond that, Riverwood gave \$3,622 in scholarships to those who could not afford the fees.
