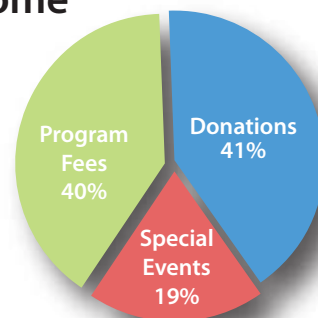
In 2013, the cost to operate the facility for 1 day = \$669

86 cents of every dollar was spent on equine-assisted activities and therapies.

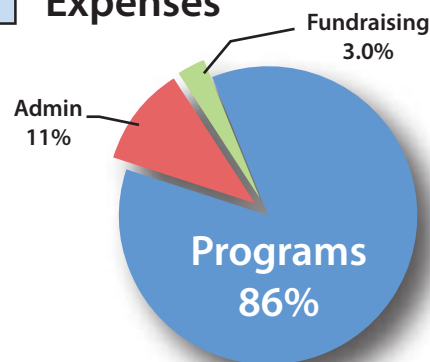
Riverwood subsidizes approximately 60% of the cost of riding lessons for all participants; beyond that, Riverwood gave \$6,120 in scholarships to those who could not afford the fees.

In 2013, Riverwood was supported by a staff of eight. The addition of a full-time instructor allowed Riverwood to meet the needs of increasing capacity.
